Beech Electrical Holdings LTD is committed to achieving net zero emissions by 2050.

- Select LED fittings with long lifespans to reduce replacement cycles.
- Bulk buying to reduce deliveries

- Return old lights, drivers, and fittings through official WEEE programmes.
- On-site waste segregation
- Move to digital certificates, RAMS, and job sheets
- Remote meetings where possible


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
